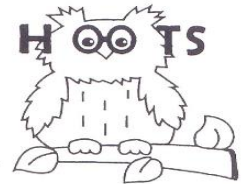

Hoots Toftwood Infant & Junior Afterschool Clubs

This Term in Hoots our afterschool children will have plenty of opportunities to get outside joining in with multi-sports, mini beast hunts, pond dipping, exploring in teds den and enjoying our great British weather. We will be exploring the topic of spring and new life in both clubs, children will have lots of opportunities to take part in spring craft, messy play with shaving foam and malleable resources such as clay, plastering and playdough.

Hoots will also be baking up a storm in their clubs, baking butterfly cakes, shortbread, rocky road biscuits and fruit kebabs. This will be spread over different nights each week allowing opportunities for all our children to participate.

Hoots gardening club will begin this term, and our children will have lots of opportunities to start preparing seedlings to be planted in our allotment located at Toftwood Junior School this will be led by Tina alongside another play worker. Children from both Hoots junior and Infants will have opportunities to participate "Green fingers at Hoots club".

Hoots Continuous Provision: Hoots offers plenty of opportunities for children to build & create and experiment with their ideas. Having areas set out for children to learn and have fun playing with role-play area including home corner, dressing up, doctors kits, hairdressers, babies, prams & much more. Our children can access various construction equipment including loose parts in the craft area, knex, Lego, wooden jenga blocks, connect straws & large construction to name a few. We have a football table and pool table, NEW Xbox one & use of the 16 computers in the ICT suite. Large outside provision including a trim trail, teds wooded area, outside classroom, cookery room, library, and lots of small world play including dinosaurs, sylvanian families, animal hospital & farm, trains, footballers, action figures and lots more.
