To Our Dear Children & Parents,

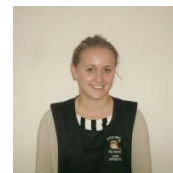

2020 has thus far been the year that everything was cancelled, however Hoots are planning to make up for some of the special events that are important to your children with some really exciting plans over the next six weeks. Our themes have been planned to offer as many opportunities for outside play, as well as the types of activities and experiences your children expect to see at Hoots, in the safest way possible.



Staff Team: Charlotte MacDonald (Manager) and Laura Patrick (Deputy Manager) will be leading Hoots summer holiday club alongside our wonderful team of playworkers. Both Charlotte and Laura have many years of experience in operating Hoots holiday clubs, which are always filled with lots of fun and laughter.



Hoots Movie Club: Will be held every Friday afternoon throughout the holidays. We have all missed the cinema, so we are going to bring the movies to Hoots. There will be a choice of two different films each Friday one aimed at our younger children and one for our older children. We will provide pre-packaged snacks and popcorn for the children and ice-cold drinks to enjoy too!



Sports days: We all look forward to sports day as one of the highlights of the summer term. Laura our Sports enthusiast will be organising a sports day each week. This will give children the opportunity to demonstrate their speed skills and agility while having fun and winning prizes both individually and for their bubble. We will also be playing group games such as football, 40:40 in, obstacle courses and non-contact IT & Stuck in the Mud.



Tik Toc & Talent Shows: It will come as no surprise to parents that Tik Toc dances and videos are immensely popular amongst our children. Each week (on a different day) Charley our very talented thespian will be supporting the children to practise their talent/song/dance/jokes for them to perform to their friends outside should they wish to.

Outdoor Activities: Will be featured each day at Hoots, the children will have the opportunity to enjoy the field and playground. We will purchase new balls, skipping ropes, games and exciting outdoor toys for our children as we are unable to use the schools trim trail. We will be using the outdoor space as much as possible including having our meals outside where possible.



Craft and Creative Play: For many children the highlight of Hoots is having the opportunity to express themselves and explore their creativity alongside their peers. This summer is no different although the way in which we access the resources will change. Children will be used to exploring 'creation stations' in club these will now be accessed only to fill their 'personal possessions pouch' we have been using this method at nursery since our reopening and it has been really successful. The children have their own creative resources that are kept in their boxes. The staff ensure all of the items are sanitized before they go back.

Food and Drink: Must be supplied from home in a clean plastic lunch box with an ice pack. Please note we are a nut free setting. A water bottle must be bought in each day also.

Personal belongings: Please only bring in what your child needs and absolutely no toys can be bought in from home.

Invoicing: All holiday club invoices must be settled by **Friday 14th August**. Could parents please pay online via online banking or child care vouchers. If cash or cheque is your only option this must be paid directly to the office not to the staff in club. Thank you for your cooperation.
