Dear Hoots families,

Welcome to our summer holiday club reservation form for 2023.

We are really excited to share with you everything we have planned for the summer and hope you all agree there is something for everyone!

Laura has been working hard alongside the Hoots staff team and children to gather ideas of what we feel the children would like to do and enjoy the most. We recommend you sit down with a cup of tea and have a good long read as there is lots of information to digest and forms to fill out for relevant sections. As it's a jam packed summer and we understand it can get confusing with what's going on, Laura has gone to the effort of creating a timetable on top of the reservation form that will be attached separately to the reservation form for your convenience. Hopefully this will help families keep better track of what's going on in club and what you will need to provide each day.

## **Trips and visits**

Much thought and consideration has gone into how we offer trips and visits for our children. Evaluation forms were sent out asking families what they can afford on top of our daily Hoots fees and these really helped guide us into knowing what we can and can't book for our Hoots children.

To make holiday club affordable and accessible for everyone we will be going on outings that are within walking distance of Hoots and as normal we will have suppliers join us in house. Laura has spent many hours ringing coach and mini bus companies (even

taxis) to find the most affordable way to take our children on trips out of Dereham and unfortunately it's very much out of budget. We hope upon reading our reservation form you will see the hard work that has gone into making it a very exciting summer for our Hoots children.

## Coming prepared for holiday club

We please ask that children come prepared for all weathers, this includes:

- Sun cream
- Sun hats
- Change of clothes and towel
- Suitable footwear
- Light rain jacket

Hoots will be going on regular outings so please check this on the booking form to ensure your child comes prepared.

We also ask that families label all of your child's belongings to help with the build-up of lost property.

Hoots don't provide lunch (unless stated on the form), please provide your child with a packed lunch and Hoots will continue to offer breakfast and snacks thorough out the day! We



please ask that families remember we are a nut free setting and pack your child with a balanced lunch box. Hoots allow treats but please ask that lunches aren't packed full of chocolate and sweets. Hoots do lots of fun activities throughout the day where children will have opportunities to have extra treats. Hoots strive to encourage healthy eating and lifestyle choices. If any of our families struggle with providing a balanced lunch over the summer please contact Laura for help.

Speaking of treats....Hoots will also be having a weekly visit from the ice cream van! You will be able to see what days this will be on the timetable. We please ask families to provide a small amount of cash for this experience or please let a member of staff know in the morning and Hoots can cover the cost and add to your invoice at the end. If you wish for your child **not** to have one from the van, Hoots will have a backup of sugar free ice pops in the freezer.

- Water play throughout the week







Children will extract DNA from bananas and/or dress up as forensic scientists and use DNA to solve the crime of 'who stole the sweets'.

On this park visit we will go armed with bug jars and magnifying glasses and become 'nature detectives'. With a week of science hopefully our Hoots children will be motivated to join in with some Bug hunts and identify different creatures!

The wonderful team from PACT animal sanctuary will be visiting us in club. On their visit with us they will do a small presentation and tell us all about what they do in the wildlife hospital.

#### Week 3- Pets & Animals

Week 3 will see pet and animal week in club! Leading on nicely from science week where Hoots would have hopefully hatched some chicks!

In club this week Hoots will have the opportunity to:


