

Our day will end with glow sticks and space music for a glowing cosmic celebration.



Thursday 19th Feb	<p>Mad Science day</p> <p>Fizz-Pop Challenge Today is about mixing safe ingredients to create bubbling volcano reactions and see whose eruption grows the biggest. This activity introduces simple chemical reactions through exciting, hands-on fun.</p> <p>Invisible Messages Hoots will write secret messages using lemon juice and reveal them with gentle heat like real scientists. This activity sparks curiosity and shows how chemistry can make the invisible visible.</p>
