Week 1 - 30th march- Thursday 2nd April

Special activity days

Monday 30th March – Easter Biscuit & Cake Decorating

On Monday, Hoots will enjoy decorating Easter-themed biscuits and cakes. They will be able to get creative with icing, sprinkles and toppings while designing their own edible masterpieces. This activity encourages creativity, fine motor skills and, of course, lots of fun!

Tuesday 31st March – Bunny visit- 2pm

On Tuesday, Hoots will enjoy a visit from some bunnies! We recently had a visit from some lovely owls and the same company are bringing along some bunnies for us to feed and cuddle!

Thursday 2nd April – Easter Bonnet Making- £2.50 extra per child to cover bonnet cost

On Thursday, we will be hosting our Easter Bonnet Day. Hoots can design and create their own Easter bonnets using a range of craft materials. There will be plenty of opportunities to personalize their hats with spring flowers, chicks, bunnies, ribbons and colorful decorations. We will celebrate everyone's creations together at the end of the day

🕒 Activities Running Throughout the Week

Easter Egg Hunts

We will be holding Easter egg hunts across the week so that all children have the opportunity to take part. These will include fun challenges, clues and teamwork elements to make each hunt exciting and engaging.

Fluffy Slime Making

Hoots will have the opportunity to make fluffy slime during the week. This sensory activity is always a favorite and allows children to experiment with textures while following simple instructions.

Week 2 Tuesday 7th- Monday 13th April

Special Activity Days

Tuesday 7th April – T-Shirt Design Day -£5 for tshirt and extra specialized craft materials

Hoots can design and create their own spring-themed t-shirts. Using fabric paints, stencils and creative techniques, they can personalise their shirts with flowers, sunshine, nature designs or their own unique artwork. This is a fantastic opportunity for self-expression and creativity.

Thursday 9th April – Mario Galaxy Themed Day

We will be hosting an exciting Mario Galaxy themed day filled with fun challenges and games inspired by the Mario universe. **Children are welcome to come dressed in bright colours or character-inspired outfits if they wish.**

Activities will include:

“Power-Up” obstacle course (collecting stars and coins)

Star hunt treasure game

Galaxy-themed colouring and drawing station

Friday 10th April – Blossom Tree Canvas Painting £1.50 to cover cost of canvas.

On Friday, Hoots can create their own blossom tree canvas artwork using paint and mixed media techniques. We will explore different painting methods to create textured blossom effects, celebrating the beauty of spring.

Monday 13th April – Trip to the Park

We will be taking a trip to the park (weather permitting), where children can enjoy outdoor games, group activities and free play in the fresh air.

Ongoing Activities Throughout the Week

Trip to the Onsite Pond and litter picking

Throughout the week, small supervised groups will visit the onsite pond area to explore nature, observe wildlife and learn about habitats. Activities may include sketching what we see, nature spotting and simple environmental discussions about caring for our surroundings.



We will also take part in supervised litter picking around the pond area, as well as around the school grounds and local area. This helps to keep our environment clean and safe for wildlife, while encouraging children to take pride in their community and understand the importance of caring for the world around them.
